This book's title refers to the elaborate game of Hide and Seek invented by two brothers, Peter and Ben, as they play on their neighbour Joseph's farm. It also refers to the tactics used by Joseph's brother Nick to persuade him to sell part of his farm in order to finance Nick's extravagant lifestyle. There are contrasts everywhere; the competitive warmth between Ben and Peter; Nick's envy for Joseph's settled lifestyle; Ed Randall's factory farming and Joseph's organic approach. Dowley is especially adept at conveying sibling rivalry but she also makes a bold, unsentimental stab at factory farming. This is a short book but it entertains and educates in equal measure.
