From the 'Racing Reads' series for 'confident readers', this title is one of a set of books about two little driftwood characters who live in an upturned boat furnished with the products of beachcombing. In this volume, our heroes are joined by a dog who proves a challenge to their experience of the world.

Innocent, gentle fun, without too much real content? the story is uneventful with the main interest deriving from the way Flotsam and Jetsam interpret and re-use their findings. I found the illustrations unattractive, but it is difficult to be convincing in the depiction of a small creature made out of driftwood, rope and tangled string. I can't quite envisage an audience for these somehow, inoffensive though they may be.
