When the Holmeses and Watsons come to live as neighbours, Saturday Holmes and Jack Watson continue the tradition of their namesakes and become detectives. Jack and Saturday are lively, well-defined characters who get themselves into some very difficult situations because of their detecting enthusiasm. 'Real books' for real readers - this is quality writing for 5-8 year-olds. The gentle tales have teddy-bear kidnappings, ghost-busting and a gloriously graphic exposé on the finer points of shadowing Mrs Grump. I loved the stories, the print size and illustrations also being appreciated by my 'typical' 7-year-old, though he found the vocabulary rather challenging.
