Three for the price of one! Lynne Reid Banks' classics - **The Indian in the Cupboard**, **Return of the Indian** and **The Secret of the Indian** - gathered together in one volume. If, by an extraordinary stroke of ill luck, you missed these gems first time round, lose no time in getting this omnibus edition. They're superb stories of a small plastic Indian, Little Bull, who comes to life when his owner, Omri, places him in a small cupboard which he's been given as a present. No whimsical characters here, but real flesh and blood people who fight battles, pick quarrels and fall in love. The reader is drawn into their world and becomes engrossed in how Little Bull and the other figures which are brought to life cope with being transported into another world. 8-year-olds upwards are captivated by these stories.
